Once that capacity is reached we will not be able to accept more until our next plant expansion or our next plant is built.

Early approvals have been shown that we can accept materials on Reels/in Boxes/Hand Coiled on pallets/and Roll-offs).

IMPORTANT: No one in the US or Canada is doing this today. If any of this material is being collected for you today, your processor may be extracting the higher quality materials from your shipments and landfilling the remains. We offer Certificates of Destruction and/or Certificates of Recycling.

One of our Recycle Processors is manufacturing products that would be useful in your industry.
