We will be collecting Fiber Optic Cable (FOC) and Coax Cable (CC) in late-June. This material will be going to our Recycling Processor (location and name of Processor(s) is not yet being announced). There are a few more FOC/CC materials to be tested, but all is going well.

This is a proprietary process.

The purpose of this memo is to request if you have interest in this effort and, if so, what are the expected quantities or volumes. Our Processor has limited capacity. **Once that capacity is reached we will not be able to accept more materials until our next facility expansion or new plant is built.**

Early approvals have been shown that we can accept materials on Reels/in Boxes/Hand Coiled on pallets/Bales/and Roll-offs bins).

IMPORTANT: No one in the US or Canada is doing this today. If by chance any of this material is being collected for you today, your processor may be extracting the higher quality materials from your shipments and landfilling the remains. **We offer Certificates of Destruction and/or Certificates of Recycling.**

One of our Recycle Processors is manufacturing products that would be useful in your industry.
